Layton 2nd Ward Emergency Plan

This plan outlines how we will organize ourselves prior to and after a large-scale emergency. The City of Layton uses local congregations as a way to gather needs assessments following an emergency event.

Flow of Information After An Emergency:

- 1. Block captains assess needs of families on their block
- 2. Block Captains report statuses to "Area Coordinators" at the ward command center: Mair's House at 3345 Overlook Drive
- 3. Information is relayed to "District Coordinators" at the stake command center(s): **Stake Center & Gentile building**
- 4. Information is relayed to Layton City via radio from the stake

Prior to Disaster

The following efforts will help us be prepared to better respond to an emergency:

- 1. Establish & train Block Captains
- 2. Set up a Ham Radio Net to facilitate communication in ward & with the Stake
- 3. Provide preparedness information & resources to households in the ward, remove barriers, & encourage individual household self-reliance
- 4. Start/facilitate self-reliance group classes
- 5. Emergency response coordinator to make list of equipment or special skills in the ward (E.g., generators, medical training, CERT training, HAM radio equipment)

Emergencies To Prepare For:

Emergencies that could occur in our ward include: pandemics, severe windstorms, snowstorms, economic disruption, earthquakes, power outages, and civil unrest. Each emergency type may require unique preparations and response efforts. Evacuation may be called for, demanding that households have portable kits to address needs for three days to two weeks. Sheltering in place in the home or out of the home may also be required both short and long-term. Individual household preparation is the key to effectively mitigating the detrimental effects of a disaster situation.
